RESORT VILLAGE OF KIVIMAA-MOONLIGHT BAY

BYLAW NO. 2/21

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF SKY LANTERNS

The Council of the Resort Village of Kivimaa-Moonlight Bay in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. It is unlawful for any individual to ignite, light, start, or allow to be ignited, lighted or started any unmanned free-floating devices capable of producing an open flame such as, but not limited to Sky Lanterns or Chinese Lanterns.
- 2. Proceedings to enforce this Bylaw shall be in accordance with the provisions of The Summary Offences Procedure Act, 1990 and amendments thereto.
- 3. Any owner found guilty of a breach of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalties Bylaw of the Resort Village of Kivimaa-Moonlight Bay.

4. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by council.
